A compound nevus is a mole that is made up of cells in both the epidermis and the dermis. The compound nevus pictured here has regular borders and uniform pigment. Scabies is an infestation produced by a mite, *Sarcoptes scabiei*, which seems to have a unique predisposition to infect only human skin. After an incubation period of about three weeks, the patient develops an allergic contact dermatitis to the mite and forms very itchy red vesicles that seem to be most common in the webs of the fingers and in the groin.
