Emery Roth (Hungarian: Róth Imre, 1871 – August 20, 1948) was an American architect of Jewish descent who designed many of the definitive New York City hotels and apartment buildings of the 1920s and 1930s, incorporating Beaux-Arts and Art Deco details. His sons continued in the family enterprise, largely expanding the firm under the name Emery Roth & Sons. Bing & Bing was one of the most important apartment real estate developers in New York City in the early 20th century.. The firm was founded by Leo S. Bing and his brother, Alexander M. Bing.
