Osteopathic medicine is a branch of the medical profession in the United States. Osteopathic doctors can be licensed to practice medicine and surgery in all 50 states and are recognized to varying degrees in 65 other countries. Frontier physician Andrew Taylor Still founded the profession as a rejection of the prevailing system of medical thought of the 19th century. The European Society for Vascular Surgery was founded and inaugurated on May 6, 1987 in London. This inaugural meeting was attended by Presidents or Representatives of almost all the National Vascular Societies in Europe, who supported the formation and aims of the ESVS.
