Clinical incidents notified in IIMS and Riskman are allocated a Severity Assessment Code (SAC) rating in accordance with NSW Health Incident Management Policy PD2014\_004.The most serious types of clinical incidents are rated as SAC1 (the other possible scores are SAC2, SAC3 or SAC4 in declining order of severity).
